# **Salvation & Grace - Cheatsheet**

## Why do humans need grace and salvation?

Christians hope that when they die they will go to heaven to be with God. They also know that human beings tend to sin against God, and so they need to find salvation (Romans 3:23). So, an important part of the Christian life is trying to avoid sin.

#### **Key Facts**

- 1. Christians believe that the life, death, resurrection and ascension of Jesus offer salvation and grace to his followers.
- 2. The importance of all of these events for Christians beliefs is that it offers the chance of salvation to all who follow Jesus and thereby receive the grace of God.
- 3. 'Grace' is described as 'unmerited favour'.
- 4. Some fundamentalist Christians believe in a literal understanding of Adam and Eve eating the forbidden fruit.
- 5. Most Christians, however, see this as a symbolic story, indicating that human beings can often be selfish and act against God's will.

### How to achieve salvation and go to heaven

Law	<ul> <li>Christians believe that God has told them how to behave, such as in the Ten Commandments, and the teachings of Jesus as found in the Gospels.</li> <li>Put simply, people can be saved if they do what God asks of them and live good lives.</li> </ul>
Grace	<ul> <li>Christians believe that salvation is a gift from God, not just something they gain by good behaviour.</li> <li>They believe that Jesus died to save people, and that this was the gift (Grace) given to them by God, regardless of whether they deserved it or not.</li> <li>Soldiers sometimes sacrifice their own lives to save their fellow soldiers, perhaps by facing the impact of a grenade.</li> <li>Christian salvation is understood as something similar, where Jesus was prepared to die in place of sinful humans.</li> </ul>
Spirit	<ul> <li>Christians believe that God has given them the Holy Spirit, which helps them to understand the Gospel and to accept that they are sinners.</li> <li>This also makes them aware of the need to be saved, which makes them more likely turn to God.</li> </ul>
